Important Proposal Timeline Information: Chosen presenters will be submitting a recorded video presentation on their accepted topics. In addition, all accepted presenters must register to attend the virtual conference on October 17, 2020. ITBE may also assign a scheduled time slot for interacting in a discussion board or potential live Question and Answer (Q & A) session with virtual attendees about their recorded

presentation. Specific details will be included with your proposal acceptance emails this fall.

ITBE's process for the virtual conference proposals will include the following:

Proposal Technology Requirements:

The presentation will be done through a prerecorded video followed by a short live Q&A session. Your entire video and Q&A should be 45 minutes in length, with a 30 to 40 minute video and remaining time Q&A. The presenter(s) must be in attendance during the whole session-while the video is playing and for the discussion afterwards.

Presentation videos can include, but are not limited to, the following recorded structures:

- Powerpoint presentation with audio recording exported as a video file
- Recorded presentation (Zoom, Web-Ex, Google Meet, etc.) displaying presentation (optional: speaker on camera) and exported as a video file
- Screencast demonstration exported as a video file
